Day sailing at PSC

Priory Sailing Club (PSC) is a family orientated club open to all and as part of this ethos the lake is available for sailing by non-club members who have their own craft on the Day Ticket scheme.

Unfortunately PSC does not currently have craft for Hire to day visitors.

Day ticket visitors are welcome to use the lake on Saturdays, Sundays, and Wednesday evenings between the dates of 1st May and 30th September each year and will be subject to the club rules, which are aimed at promoting safe sailing and care of the environment.

Day tickets cover single hull sailing boats under 16 feet, canoes & kayaks (including an inflatable canoes but not an inflatable rowing dinghy).

The current rates for Day Tickets are:

Sailing Dinghy \pounds 7:00
Boards \pounds 6.00
Canoe/Kayak \pounds 2.00
*After 14:00hrs half price

Plus per participant £ 1:00

The purchaser of a day ticket will be informed prior to the purchase as to the closing time of the Lake i.e when either the safety boat will be removed or the Officer Of the Day (OOD) is closing the Club. This is likely to be 17:00hrs on weekends.

Members of the public wishing to use the Lake are required to hold their own craft Insurance (including 3^{rd} party liability insurance to a minimum of £1m) – The day ticket requires the Visitor to sign to say that they have such insurance.

Visitors are also advised that:-

- A Two Boat Rule applies on the water (for safety) unless a Safety boat is present on the water.
- Participants covered by the day ticket must wear Buoyancy Aids.
- An Officer of the Club has the right to withhold the sale of the Day Ticket, and to ask for the craft or participants to come off the water.
