

NHS Test and Trace

As part of the NHS Test and Trace initiative the club has a legal obligation to keep records of members that visit our club.

For many of our activities we already have a 'register' of who is attending – Eventbrite records who has booked a boat or is attending our adult and junior coaching sessions, Dutyman keeps track of our coaches and our Race Officers, and our race result sheet records who is racing on any given Sunday.

However if you are coming to the club for any reason other than those listed above we are required to ask you to record your visit to our club.

There are two ways that you can do this –

1. If you have a smart phone, and have downloaded the NHS Test and Trace app, you can scan one of the QR codes that we have on display (again we are legally required to display these). There is one on the left as you come through the gate, one in the window of our wet classroom and one on a door near the rescue boat store. They are all the same, you need only scan one! This will record your visit to our club.
2. If you don't have the app please simply record your visit on the paper list that is on the window of the wet classroom. All that is required is the date, your name, your arrival time and your estimated time of departure. The list will be replaced weekly and will be kept for the required twenty one days.

Only one person from each 'party' needs to record their visit. Anyone accompanying someone who is being coached, or is racing, does not need to record their visit.

Our membership list has your contact details, so keeping us updated if these change is now more important than ever.
